

## 2008 Presidential Election Timeline

<b>September 9, 2008</b>	Delaware holds statewide Primary Election.
<b>September 10–October 11</b>	Registered voters in Delaware may change political party affiliation.
<b>October 11, 2008</b>	Deadline for registered voters in Delaware to change political party affiliation before the General Election.
<b>October 11, 2008</b>	Registration deadline for Delaware voters to register to vote in the 2008 General Election.
<b>October 31, 2008</b>	Last day Departments of Elections in Delaware’s three counties are required to mail absentee ballots.
<b>November 4, 2008</b>	General Election Day across the United States. In each state the voters choose a slate of electors to serve in the Electoral College. Forty-eight states employ a “winner take all” system (exceptions are Maine and Nebraska).
<b>November 4, 2008</b>	Deadline for Delaware’s absentee voters to return absentee ballots.
<b>December 15, 2008</b>	Electoral College Meets—electors meet in their state capitals to select a President and Vice-President.
<b>December 24, 2008</b>	Deadline for receipt of electoral votes at the National Archives and Records Administration.
<b>January 3, 2008</b> (on or before)	Electoral College votes transmitted to Congress.
<b>January 6, 2008</b>	Electoral College votes counted before a joint session of Congress.
